Testing Update

Save the Date

The ACT will be given to all 11th grade students on Tuesday, October 31 and Tuesday, March 26 during the school day. (This will be paper based testing.) The Digital SAT will be given to all 11th grade students on March 7, 2024 during the school day. Students will not need to register for these assessments and there will be no charge. More information will be sent out closer to each testing date.

Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST)

The Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) is a progress monitoring tool that will be administered to all 9th and 10th grade students three times per year to track your student's progress in learning the Benchmarks of Excellent Student Thinking (B.E.S.T.) Standards throughout this school year.

The assessment is computer based and is 60 minutes in length and students can have up to 90 minutes. Any students who are approved for extra time (according to IEP or 504) will have an additional 45 minutes so 135 minutes in total. 9th grade students will test on Thursday, January 19. Testing location and time will be emailed to student SCPS email and parent email in January. Students should bring a reading book. 10th grade students will test on Friday, January 20. Testing location and time information will be emailed to students and parents in January. The FAST parent letter with more information is attached.
