Attendance Matters

Last year, Skipping was by far our #1 discipline infraction. and in the second semester alone, almost 400 students had credit denied in classes due to 10+ unexcused absences. Good attendance is absolutely critical to student success, and we need the help of all family members in supporting student attendance. Following are a few tips for parents/caregivers:

- Talk to your child about the importance of good attendance and agree to a time each week to review attendance and grades in Skyward with your child.
- Submit notes for excused absences to the Attendance office or email them to Imhs_attendance@scps.us. These notes can be from a doctor or a parent. *Please remember you have 5 school days after the absence to submit the note.
- If your child has credit denial, ensuring 5 or fewer unexcused absences this semester will reinstate the credit.

- The student has not met the prerequisite.
- There is a "hole" in the schedule during that period.
- Missing a core academic class (English, Math, Science or Social Studies [10-12])
- Enrolled in a Dual Enrollment Course (Must have contract completed and proof of SSC course registration).
- Enrolled in a Virtual Course (Must register for course prior to schedule change).
