Testing Update

ACT School Day - Tuesday, March 26

The ACT will be given to all 11th grade students on Tuesday, March 26 during the school day. Any 12th grade student who has not yet met the reading and/or math graduation requirement will be scheduled to take the non-college reportable ACT for a concordant score.

Testing location information will be emailed to students and parents this week. Students take the ACT for college admissions and also for concordant scores that meet graduation requirements. This is paid for by the district so is a free opportunity. Testing will begin at 7:20am and will finish by 11:50am. All students who are testing will go to 2nd lunch at 11:58am then Periods 6 and 7 will be regular classes. There will be no make-ups for the ACT.

Students should bring pencils and a calculator. Calculators will not be provided.

Florida Civic Literacy Exam (FCLE) - Seniors

Beginning with students initially entering a Florida College System institution or state university in the 2021-2022 school year and thereafter, each student must demonstrate competency in civic literacy by achieving a passing score on an assessment and by successfully completing a civic literacy course. s 1007.25(5)(b).

This exam consists of approximately 80 multiple choice questions and is one 160-minute session. To learn more about this exam, <u>CLICK HERE</u>.

The FCLE is not required for high school graduation but is required for students who plan on graduating from a four year college.

12th grade students took the FLCE in Fall 2023 and can sign up to take it again on **Tuesday, April 9** if they would like to take it again. Students will not be scheduled to take it and need to sign up at: tinyurl.com/Spring2024FCLE

B.E.S.T. Writing Test (9th & 10th Grade)

9th and 10th grade students will be scheduled to participate in the BEST Writing assessment which is administered in one 120-minute session. 9th grade students will be scheduled to test on April 1 or 2 and 10th grade students will be scheduled to test on April 4 or 5.

Student testing locations will be emailed to students and parents after Spring Break.
