#### **SAT School Dav**

The Digital SAT will be given to all 11th grade students on Thursday, March 7 during the school day. Some students who have accommodations will be scheduled to test on Wednesday, March 6. 11th grade students will take the SAT free of charge. Students do not need to register for this.

All students in the testing area will be required to power off their electronic devices because of the bandwidth needed for the digital SAT testing. This should be from approximately 7:25am until 11:00am. If you need to contact your student during that timeframe, please call the Attendance Office at 407-320-9553.

Students should bring pencils, a calculator, and snacks. Calculators will not be provided. CLICK HERE to view the SAT Calculator Policy.

Testing will begin at 7:20am and will finish by 11:00am and will then go to regular classes. CLICK HERE to view the SAT Student Guide. Students can set up a College Board account at www.collegeboard.org and can link their account to Khan Academy where they have access to official SAT practice items.

Student testing locations have been emailed to students and parents and are posted outside Media. The SAT Parent Letter is attached.

#### Florida Civic Literacy Exam (FCLE) - Seniors

Beginning with students initially entering a Florida College System institution or state university in the 2021-2022 school year and thereafter, each student must demonstrate competency in civic literacy by achieving a passing score on an assessment and by successfully completing a civic literacy course. s 1007.25(5)(b).

This exam consists of approximately 80 multiple choice questions and is one 160-minute session. To learn more about this exam, CLICK HERE.

The FCLE is not required for high school graduation but is required for students who plan on graduating from a four year college.

12th grade students took the FLCE in Fall 2023 and can sign up to take it again on Tuesday, April 9 if they would like to take it again. Students will not be scheduled to take it and need to sign up at: tinyurl.com/Spring2024FCLE
