Virtual Courses

SENIORS MUST COMPLETE ALL VIRTUAL COURSES BY MAY 1, 2024. All SCVS/FLVS classes must be completed by the deadline provided by your online teacher. Make sure you stay on task with the modules in your course. All students enrolled in a virtual course must complete the virtual contract and return it to your school counselor. Students met with a Lake Mary High School Counselor earlier this semester to select courses for the 2024-25 school year. Skyward is now open for students to view their selections (this is only open from the student Skyward account.) If they would like to make changes, NOW is the time, so please see the information below:

Schedule Change Request for 2024_25

·For LMHS courses, please use this <u>link</u> to request a change. Please keep in mind that, at this time, we cannot change students who are scheduled for Remedial Reading and/or Math, Acceleration or Required courses.

To replace an LMHS course with an SCVS course, there are two parts:

- First, please submit a request on the SCVS site.
- Second, request a change to the LMHS schedule using the link in bullet number one. Students should note if they prefer an on-campus virtual lab or off-campus. If off-campus, please note the period/s requesting off. If your student is an incoming ninth grader, please also update your SCVS account to reflect LMHS so that our counselors will be able to see the request.
- Additionally, YOU MUST SUBMIT your Virtual Contract prior to any changes (SIGN by both parent and studentattachment)

Dual Enrollment: School counselors are not contracted over the summer so please make sure your student schedules an appointment with their school counselor before the end of April to get dual enrollment in order. Students should visit this site to get basic information and bring the appropriate forms to the counselor meeting (copy of FALL schedule from SSC is required).

Schedule changes will be VERY limited in the fall.

The deadline to request changes for the next school year is Friday, May 10, 2024.

Testing Update

Advanced Placement Testing

AP Exams will take place May 6-17 (schedule is attached). All exams will take place at Lake Mary High School. This is a reminder that students are expected to take the AP exam at the end of the course and if a student does not sit for the AP exam, there will be a \$40 unused exam fee.

Cell phones and smart watches will not be permitted in the testing room. Students may not be dismissed until the exam has officially ended.

Students will need a current government-issues or school-issued photo ID (students MUST have photo ID) for AP testing.

This past Friday, an email was sent to all AP students and parents with exam information about the specific AP(s) you are taking which ensures that an exam was ordered. If you did not receive this information by email(s), please contact kathleen aslin@scps.us

Specific AP testing information will be emailed to students and parents soon.

As a reminder, students get one free score send each year they take an AP Exam, and their score report will include their AP scores from this year and any previous years. Colleges and universities use official score reports to determine credit or placement, if applicable. Students have until June 20, 2024, to change their free score-send selection. Starting on April 10, when students sign in to My AP, they'll see a pop-up window prompting them to choose a college, university, or scholarship organization to receive their AP scores for free.

Their official score report will be sent in July, and it will include scores for the AP Exams that they take this year as well as any past AP Exam scores.
