Virtual Courses

Student Email

Students, please ensure that you check your email at least twice a week. Email is a primary way for many to communicate. To get to your school email, you will log on to your Clever Portal and select the Office 365 application. From there, you can check and respond to important information and review school announcements that are sent to all students and families.

Letters of Recommendation

Seniors as you are starting to apply to college, requests for letters will come to your school counselor. Be sure to complete the "Counselor Letter of Recommendation" form located in the Student Services Office or on our school website. You may email this directly to your counselor. Please allow 2 weeks for processing. Also, ensure all information requested on the form is completed so that your counselor can compose an appropriate letter.

Testing Update

Florida Civic Literacy Exam (FCLE) - Seniors

Beginning with students initially entering a Florida College System institution or state university in the 2021-2022 school year and thereafter, each student must demonstrate competency in civic literacy by achieving a passing score on an assessment and by successfully completing a civic literacy course. s 1007.25(5)(b).

This exam consists of approximately 80 multiple choice questions and is one 160-minute session. To learn more about this exam, CLICK HERE.

The FCLE is not required for high school graduation but is required for students who plan on graduating from a four year college.

12th grade students took the FLCE in Fall 2023 and can sign up to take it again on **Tuesday, April 9** if they would like to take it again. Students will not be scheduled to take it and need to sign up at: tinyurl.com/Spring2024FCLE

SAT School Day Results (11th Grade)

The results from the SAT School Day (March 7) are now available in student College Board accounts and will be in Skyward soon. Juniors can use a concordant SAT math score of 420 to meet the Algebra 1 EOC graduation requirement and a concordant SAT score of ERW 480 meets the FSA ELA reading graduation requirement.

Testing Update

Advanced Placement Testing

AP Exams will take place May 6-17 (schedule is attached). All exams will take place at Lake Mary High School. This is a reminder that students are expected to take the AP exam at the end of the course and if a student does not sit for the AP exam, there will be a \$40 unused exam fee.

Cell phones and smart watches will not be permitted in the testing room. Students may not be dismissed until the exam has officially ended.

Students will need a current government-issues or school-issued photo ID (students MUST have photo ID) for AP testing.

This past Friday, an email was sent to all AP students and parents with exam information about the specific AP(s) you are taking which ensures that an exam was ordered. If you did not receive this information by email(s), please contact kathleen aslin@scps.us

Specific AP testing information will be emailed to students and parents soon.

As a reminder, students get one free score send each year they take an AP Exam, and their score report will include their AP scores from this year and any previous years. Colleges and universities use official score reports to determine credit or placement, if applicable. Students have until June 20, 2024, to change their free score-send selection. Starting on April 10, when students sign in to My AP, they'll see a pop-up window prompting them to choose a college, university, or scholarship organization to receive their AP scores for free.

Their official score report will be sent in July, and it will include scores for the AP Exams that they take this year as well as any past AP Exam scores.
