Lake Mary High School PARKING DECAL APPLICATION 2022-2023

Dual Enrollment, Off-Campus Virtual School, OJT, Athletics, and Extra-Curricular activities DO NOT GUARANTEE you a parking pass on campus. If you are relying on any of these options to obtain a pass, you may want to consider other transportation methods for the upcoming school year.

General Parking Rules:

1. ALL DEBTS AND OBLIGATIONS MUST BE CLEARED WITH THE BOOKKEEPER PRIOR TO OBTAINING A PARKING PASS. Please use this link to pay any student debt: [Pay My Student Debt](#)
2. Permits will ONLY be sold to **Juniors and Seniors**.
3. All vehicles must have the 2022-2023 school issued permit/tag to park on campus.
4. Cost of the parking pass is **\$80**.
5. In order to obtain a parking pass/tag, students must provide a **copy of all** of the following documents:
 - a. **Valid Driver's License Not a Learners Permit (Student Must Provide his/her own Copy)**
 - b. **Vehicle Registration (Student Must Provide his/her own Copy)**
 - c. **Completed Notarized Application for Parking – Next page.**
6. Parking passes must be displayed **CLEARLY** so the number can be seen through the windshield, no other items should be hung from the rear-view mirror. **(NO EXCEPTIONS)**
7. Lost or stolen parking passes or any vehicle changes must be reported to the Discipline Office immediately.
8. Replacement parking passes will be subject to a fee of \$40.00, and the original hanging decal will be retired and must be returned to discipline if found.
9. Lake Mary High School is **NOT** responsible for any damages to vehicles or personal property.
10. Students may not park in any other area on campus except for the areas designated for student parking.
11. **Students leaving campus without authorization will have their parking passes revoked and face disciplinary action.**
12. **Student's vehicles are subject to search per school board policy. Board Policy Number 5771**
 - *School authorities are charged with the responsibility of safeguarding the safety and well-being of the students in their care. In the discharge of that responsibility, school authorities may search the person or property, including vehicles, of a student, with or without the student's consent, whenever they reasonably suspect that the search is required to discover evidence of a violation of law or of school rules.*
13. Speed limit on campus is 10 MPH.
14. **Students must exit their vehicles and the parking lot area immediately upon arriving to school.**
15. **Students are not allowed in the parking lot during school hours without administrator approval.**
16. The school reserves the right to revoke parking passes from students as a discipline consequence.
17. Duplication of a parking passes will result in the loss of your parking privileges for the remainder of the year-- along with the appropriate disciplinary action.

Parking Sale Dates:

Seniors Only: July 18, 2022, through July 22, 2022, **ONLINE ONLY** (**While Supplies Last**).

Seniors/Juniors: July 25, 2022, through July 29, 2022, **ONLINE ONLY** (**While Supplies Last**).

Parking Sales will be available starting at 12:00 am on selected dates.

Pickup Date: Seniors/Juniors pickup will be on Tuesday, August 2, 2021, in the auditorium lobby any time from 9:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. If you cannot make it on this date, you will be able to pick up your decal in the bookkeeping office any time after August 3, 2022. Office Hours Monday-Friday 8:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m. (Once Purchased online parking is secured, no need to rush on the day of pickup)

Parking on the Lake Mary High School campus is a privilege. In order to retain this privilege, I agree to abide by all parking rules and regulations listed above. **Failure to do so can result in my vehicle being towed at my expense, parking privileges revoked, a traffic citation issued, and/or disciplinary action taken.**
